



Rules and Regulations For OPEN CLASS in the ART & AG HALLS Guthrie County Fair

Please complete the ENTRY FORM allowing 3 days for mail service and mail to the address below. OR a drop off box for entries can be found on the southeast corner of the Guthrie Co. Event Center by the Secretary's window.

1. Entry forms must be to the secretary's office by Monday, August 31, at 6:00 P.M.
2. Exhibit tags can be picked up from 9 A.M. to 7:00 P.M. on Thursday.
3. All exhibits must be to the Art Hall or Ag Hall by Thursday at 7:30 PM.
Exceptions: Baked Goods and flowers. These must be to the Art Hall by 7:30 A.M. the day of judging (Friday).
4. Judging in the Ag Hall and Art Hall will begin at 9:00 on Friday. The Ag Hall will be OPEN to the public during judging.
5. The Art Hall will be CLOSED to the public during judging, but will open at 6 p.m. Friday night for public viewing.
6. Exhibitors may enter only **one article per class and lot number** in every department. **No exceptions.**
7. Open class exhibitors will be furnished with cards/tags containing the section, class, and lot number as exhibitor submitted of each item. Cards/tags must be attached or placed in close connection with the exhibit to which they refer.
8. ALL open class and jr. class vegetables will be judged according to the Iowa State Extension Leaflet 4-H-462 that can be obtained at the Extension Office.
9. Look for the correct number to be displayed for each class.
10. All products must be grown in the current year. If any entry, in any lot is below standard, first prize will not be awarded even if it is the only one in the lot.
11. Ag Hall exhibitors will furnish their own paper plate to display their exhibit on.
12. If it is ascertained that any exhibitor has made or caused to be made, any false statements in regard to any article exhibited, or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with, or influence the judges in the performance of their duties, the exhibitor shall be excluded from the competition or exhibition.
13. Decision of the awarding judge shall be final, except in cases of fraud or protest.
14. Exhibits may be picked up between 1:00 and 3:00 on Monday. No exhibits may be removed before 1:00 p.m.
